

The Sun Letters and The Moon Letters

Assalamu Alaikum Children,

We all know the 28 Arabic letters. They are divided into two groups based on the way they join with the definite article 'ال' (the). The 14 letters that get assimilated with the article 'ال' and silence the sound of 'ل' are called the Sun Letters, حُرُوفُ الشَّمْسِيَّةِ. The other 14 letters that join the article without affecting its sound are called the Moon Letters, حُرُوفُ الْقَمَرِيَّةِ.
